

Structure of the Group Profile report






The box-and-whisker graphic


Shows the distribution of scores in the group (relative to VoicePrint norms)



With more detail as you hover




Pressure Profile




The Line Plot

Named or anonymous




'Toggling'

A way of exploring specific contributions and relationships




Exploring a particular relationship
